This second issue of the eleventh volume of JIDM brings four articles, one extended version of best papers from the XX Brazilian Symposium on GeoInformatics – GEOINFO 2019. GEOINFO was held in São José dos Campos, Brazil, from November 11^{th} to November 13^{th} , 2019, and three article regularly submitted to the Journal.

Section GEOINFO 2020 includes extended and revised versions of papers selected from GEOINFO 2019.
